This involved planning and executing both internal and external projects and workshops in partnership with various UN agencies, local governments, and NGOs, targeting citizens and university students in Nepal. I managed the organization's social media channels and generated communication materials to promote volunteerism. Additionally, I oversaw the recruitment and training of over 80 international and national volunteers, leading community outreach programs and informative talks in multiple provinces. A highlight was facilitating the United Nations Day celebration in 2023, which was honorued by the visit of UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres. Through this internship, I aimed to enhance my cross-cultural communication skills and broaden my international horizons while applying the skills and knowledge I developed during my studies.
