All applicants are required to submit a brief, either in English or Chinese of around 200 words relating to their background in volunteer service and how the selected programme will benefit them in the future.

A Selection Committee will award scholarships to applicants who present the best submissions.

Some courses may not include in the Community Service Scholarship. Applicants are required to fulfil the course requirement and submit course application form and supporting document, if necessary. Acceptance is subject to the discretion of the Association.
