2005年成立,由香港青年協會駐校社工石伙蓮女士帶領,成員來自佛教黃允殿中學中二至中六學生,主要吸納欠缺自信、目標及成就感的學生,讓他們透過幫助別人發揮「燃亮生命、豐富生命」的精神,提升他們的自尊自信,並培育善善德,服務社群。義工隊服務由學生自行構思、籌備、推行及檢討,透過經驗學習,啟發潛能。

除校內服務外,義工隊更夥拍不同團體策劃義工服務,對象包括智障人士、長者、 戒毒青少年、有特殊學習需要的學童及區內居民等。Vnet義工服務隊展現青年 人的可塑性及生命力,突顯正面成長的無限可能,在幫助他人的同時,也改善 學生的行為及促進品德發展,並感染其他學生參與,使義工隊得以持續發展, 為學校及社會樹立模範。義工隊多次獲邀到社福機構、教育局、學校及媒體擔任 嘉賓,分享如何以義務工作促進學生成長,成果獲得肯定。

能夠走出學校,投入社會接觸有需要的人士及弱勢社群,義工服務隊用心做好 每個環節。作為學校義工隊的成功例子,Vnet隊員更到不同機構宣揚義工精神, 如參與中學巡禮、優質社會服務分享等等,介紹義務工作如何提升學習成效。

Volunteer Network Team (Vnet) was set up in 2005 and led by Ms Shek For Lin Stony, the School Social Worker of the Hong Kong Federation of Youth Groups, with members coming from Form II to Form VI students of Buddhist Wong Wan Tin College, who lacked self-confidence, direction and sense of achievement. Vnet nurtured them with the spirit of "Brightening Life and Enriching Life" through the experience to help others; so as, to develop the students' self-confidence and to build a healthy character. The students were given the opportunities to take responsibilities for the design, planning, implementation and review of the Vnet services, their potentials could be fully exercised through the volunteering process.

Apart from performing service within school, Vnet also partnered with different organizations to plan volunteer service targeted at the mentally retarded, the elderly, young people under anti-drug treatment, special educational needs students and residents within the district. Indeed, Vnet showed the mouldable nature of young people, their life power and unlimited potentials for positive development. In the course of helping other people, Vnet also helped improve the behaviour of students, promote the personality development, and influence other students to join in. Vnet has received many invitations from different organizations and the mass media to be guest to share experiences on how volunteer service works to promote the development of students.

To serve the underprivileged, Vnet attended to every service details in pursuit for excellence. As a success study of school volunteer team, Vnet members often go to different organizations to promote the spirit of volunteerism, to showcase how volunteer service could raise learning effectiveness.
