Community Leaders and Celebrities Join Hands to Show Care and Celebrate the Mid-Autumn Festival with Elderly Territory-wide support for the Hong Kong Volunteer Award "Volunteer Tram" officially launched.

(Hong Kong · 5 September 2022) **The Hong Kong Volunteer Award** (HKV-Award), a territory-wide scheme co-organized by **the Home and Youth Affairs Bureau** and **the Agency for Volunteer Service** ("AVS"), was successfully launched in August 2022 to encourage more people and young people to volunteer and build a caring and inclusive society. To further promote the HKV-Award, and to highlight the importance of volunteerism to the community, as well as the importance of volunteer recognition and encouragement, the AVS organized a Volunteer Service Day cum Territory-wide "Catch the Volunteer Tram" event in Western District today, which was well-supported by many celebrities from the political, business, sports and arts sectors.

The Secretary for Home and Youth Affairs, Miss Alice Mak, together with the Chairman of the AVS, Ms Melissa Kaye Pang, the Director (Property Management) of Hong Kong Housing Society, Mr Sanford Poon and famous artist Mr Lok-yi Lai, visited the elderly at Kwun Lun Lau in Kennedy Town today to present caring gifts to the elderly. Secretary Alice Mak set an example for the community by acting as both a volunteer and a commentator. Secretary Mak said she appreciated the selflessness of the volunteers who sacrificed their spare time and family time to organize volunteer activities and care for the needy in the community. The event was a great success. To continue the care and concern, the AVS will distribute the gift packs to NGOs in the Central and Western Districts to encourage volunteers to care for the local community.
